I wanna describe the perfect relationship, like Julie and Klaus, and the reason to read it would be that everyone really likes this couple.

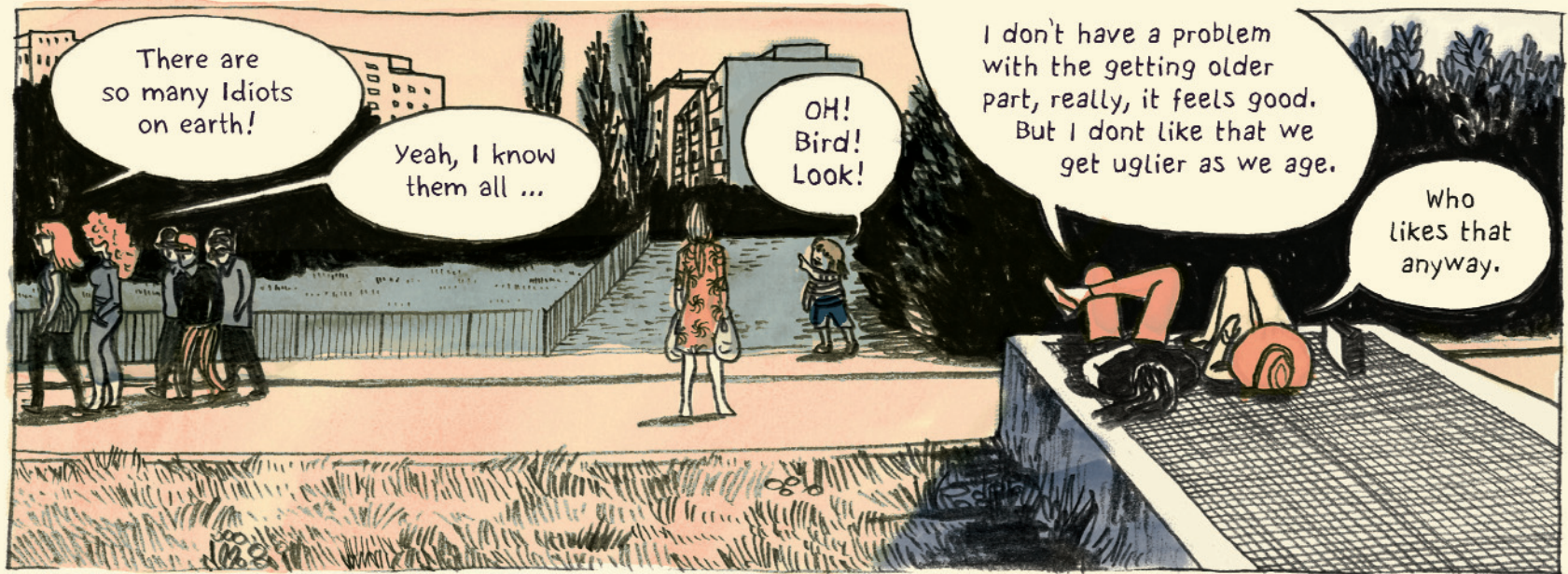
I gave it to Sarah, she was supposed to read it first ... and do you know what she said?











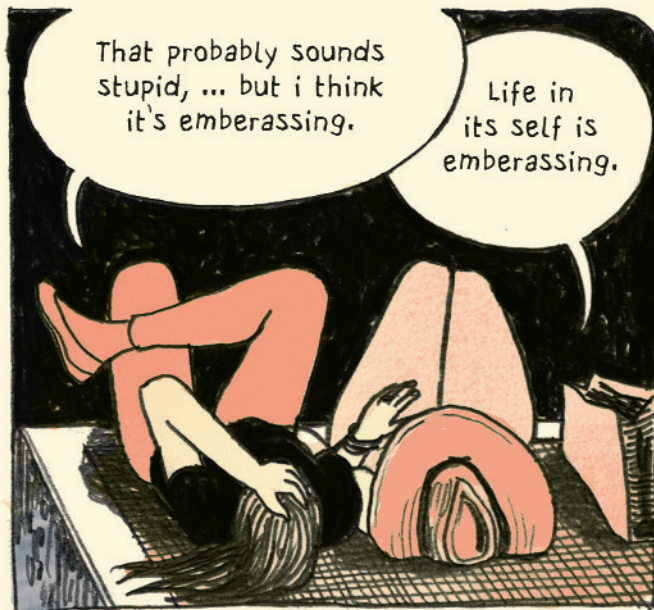

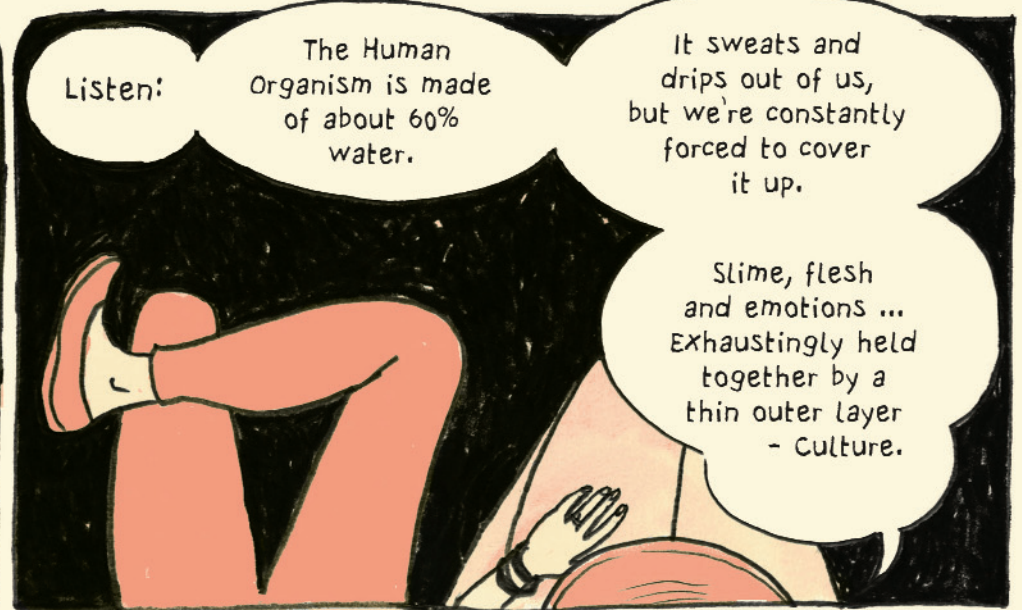
I don't have a problem with the getting older part, really, it feels good. But I dont like that we get uglier as we age.
